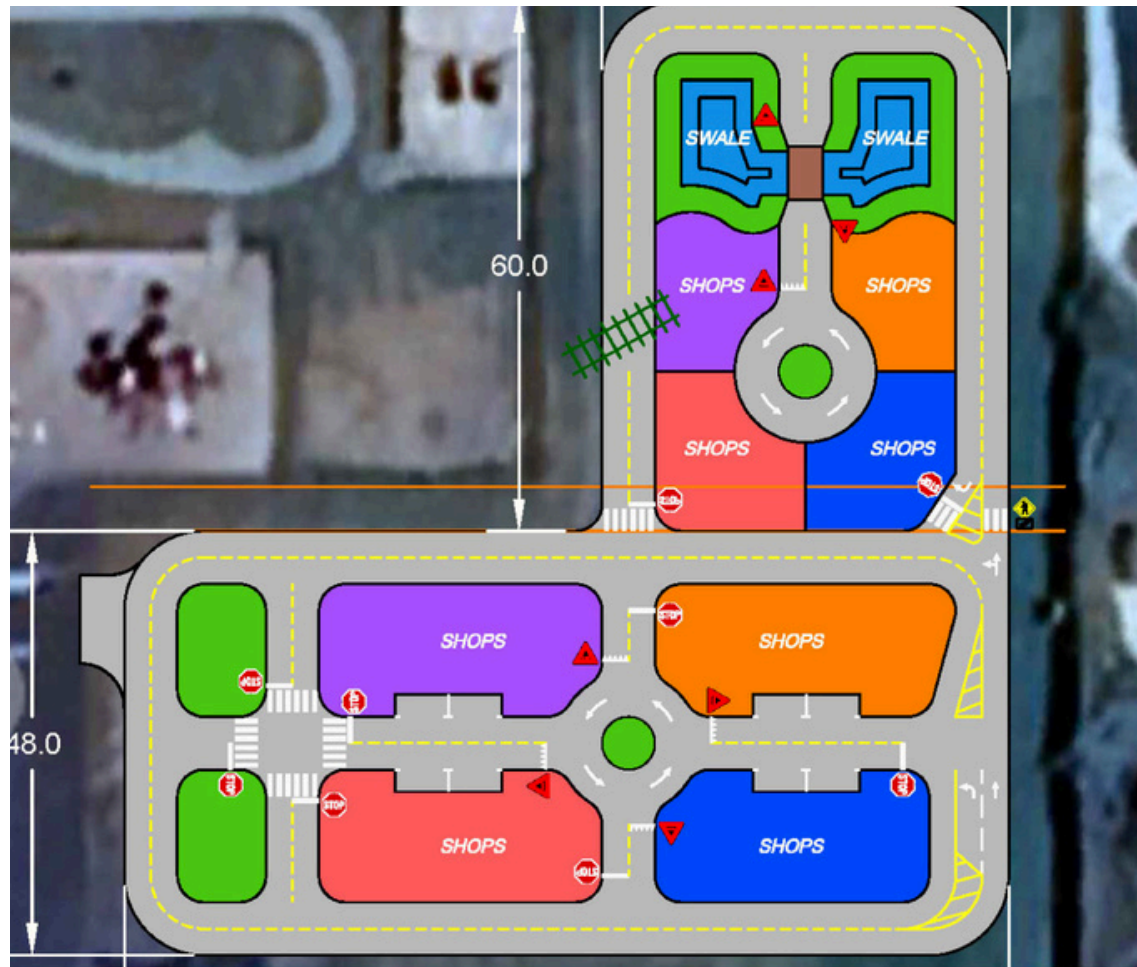

SCOPE OF WORK



PERMANENT TRAFFIC GARDEN

A dedicated, scaled-down traffic environment where children can practice walking, biking, and traffic navigation.



MOBILE TRAFFIC GARDEN

A portable setup for schools, camps, and events, along with a curriculum for facilitators.



CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

Guided by project workgroup and delivered to educators, facilitators, community partners and participants.

MOBILE GRANT BUDGET

A portable, pop-up version of a permanent traffic safety course designed to teach children safe walking and biking behaviors. Using lightweight materials like signs, cones, turf, and chalk, it can be quickly set up at schools, parks, and community events—bringing hands-on traffic safety education directly to kids in their own neighborhoods.

SITE DEVELOPMENT: \$113,400

Asphalt installation for 46' x 60' and 48' x 100' square feet.

ENGINEERING: DONATED!

SITE FINISH WORK: \$25,500

Surveying, striping, clearcoat and signage.

MOBILE TRAILER: \$10,000

Includes racks for bicycles.

STORAGE SHED: \$4,500

8' x 16' with delivery and installation.

CONTRACT SERVICES: \$10,000

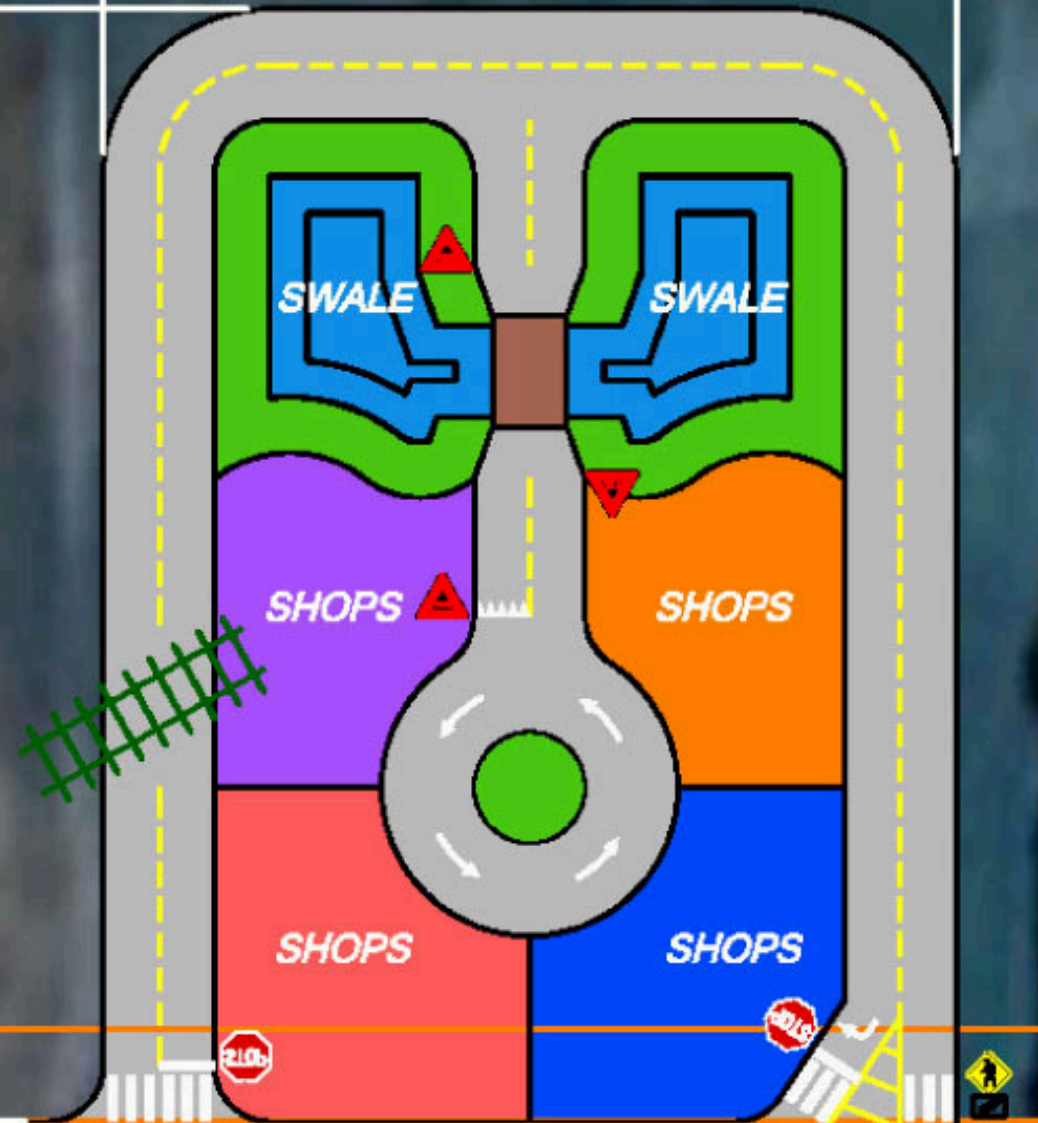
Manual labor and Promotional campaign consultant fees.

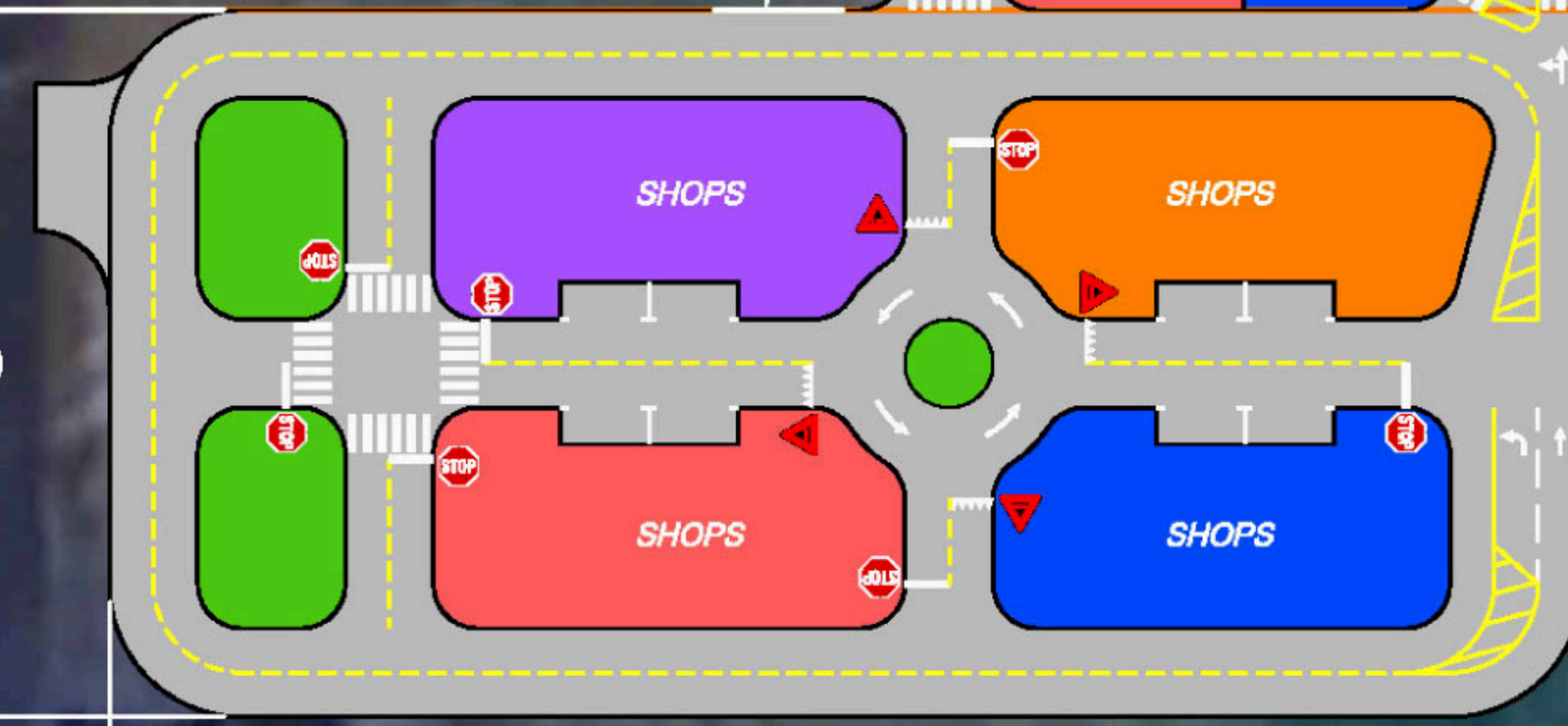
